**VOLUNTARY AGREEMENT TO RESIGN FROM
JUDICIAL OFFICE IN LIEU OF DISCIPLINARY ACTION**

This Agreement is being entered into by the undersigned parties pursuant to Section 33.032(h) of the Texas Government Code.

WHEREAS on November 12, 2004, a complaint was filed with the State Commission on Judicial Conduct (hereinafter the "Commission") containing allegations of judicial misconduct against Judge Michael L. Glover, Municipal Court Judge, Brookshire, Waller County, Texas, regarding his failure to comply with mandatory judicial educational requirements for fiscal year 2004.

WHEREAS on or about January 20, 2005, in connection with the above-referenced matter, the Commission received an affidavit (hereinafter the "January 20, 2005 Sworn Complaint") from Hope Lochridge, the Executive Director of the Texas Municipal Courts Education Center, confirming the allegations of misconduct raised in the original complaint (a true and correct copy of the January 20, 2005 Sworn Complaint is attached hereto as Exhibit A), and

WHEREAS on or about July 1, 2005, the Commission recommended to the Supreme Court of Texas that Judge Glover be suspended, pursuant to Article 5, §1-a(6)A of the Texas Constitution and Rule 15(b) of the Procedural Rules for the Removal or Retirement of Judges, and

WHEREAS on October 11, 2005, the Texas Supreme Court issued an Order of Suspension against Judge Glover, suspending him from office, without pay, pending final disposition of the charges against him, and

WHEREAS no Notice of Formal Proceedings has been filed by the Examiner against Judge Glover in connection with the above-referenced matter, and

WHEREAS no Findings of Fact or Conclusions of Law have been made in connection with the above-referenced matter, and

WHEREAS the parties agree that the allegations of judicial misconduct, if found to be true, would result in further disciplinary action against Judge Glover, and

WHEREAS the parties to this Agreement are desirous of resolving these matters without the time and expense of further disciplinary proceedings.

IT IS THEREFORE AGREED that Judge Glover, upon the signing of this Agreement, shall resign his judicial office in lieu of disciplinary action by the Commission, pursuant to Section 33.032(h) of the Texas Government Code. The Commission agrees that it shall pursue no further disciplinary proceedings against Judge Duncan in connection with the above-referenced matter.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED that, upon the Commission's approval of this Agreement, Judge Glover shall not be disqualified from future judicial service; sitting or serving as a judge in the State of Texas in the future; or standing for election or appointment to judicial office in the State of Texas.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED that any violation of this Agreement by Judge Glover would constitute willful or persistent conduct that is clearly inconsistent with the proper performance of his duties or casts public discredit upon the judiciary or administration of justice in violation of Art. 5, Section 1-a(6)A of the Texas Constitution, and Section 33.001(b) of the Texas Government Code.


IT IS FURTHER AGREED that the Commission may enforce this Agreement through any legal process necessary, including injunctive relief; that Travis County, Texas, shall be the proper venue for any dispute between the parties or proceeding relating to this Agreement; and that Judge Glover, individually, shall bear the expense, cost, and any reasonable and necessary attorneys' fees in the event any dispute arising under this Agreement is decided against his by any court or tribunal.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED that Judge Glover, by his execution of this voluntary agreement, does not admit guilt, fault or liability regarding the matters contained in Exhibit A attached hereto.

AGREED TO AND ACCEPTED upon its execution by the parties.
